



Tàijí Symbol

Tài (standing person with extra dot for emphasis): *very big, too, excessively, extremely*

Jí (wood, tree + person in center struggling with mouth and hands between heaven and earth, urgently, anxiously): *ridgepole, extreme, extremely*

Tàijí together suggests Great Polarities or Ultimate Extremes.

Tàijí emanates from wújí (no-polarities) - the unnamed Dào prior to any namable distinctions or separations. In Tàijí Quán martial art the wújí posture is a state of no-intention before any action is begun.
